### **CEMETERY WOES**

Due to a substantial reduction in the monies Our Cemetery receives from the Diocese which invests our Perpetual Care Funds (approx \$120,000), we face a major cash shortfall this year. We also need to raise our rates to be in line with the other parochial cemeteries in town. We will be raising our rates as of August 1<sup>st</sup>. In the interim, single plots are available for \$750 + \$200 (corner markers) + HST for a total of \$1073.50. A single plot can accommodate a full burial or up to three urns.
