Reading for the day Matthew 11:16-19, 25-30 - Jesus said, "To what will I compare this generation? It is like children sitting in the marketplaces and calling to one another, 'We played the flute for you, and you did not dance; we wailed, and you did not mourn.' For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, 'He has a demon'; the Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, 'Look, a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!' Yet wisdom is vindicated by her deeds." At that time Jesus said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and the intelligent and have revealed them to infants; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will. For the Hebrews, the word rain (geshem) also means “substance”, specifically a divine substance which gives life. In a semi-arid environment like in Israel, it is only natural that the people would have developed such a reverence or rain. It is a blessing!

North America has 25% of the world's supply of fresh water, serving only 5% of the world's total population, which doesn't mean it should go to waste. In order to reduce your fresh water consumption, install a rain barrel. Simply place the barrel under the gutter. Once elevated, water runs by gravity through your hose to water your garden. What a blessing! You can purchase a rain barrel at a hardware store.

To The People of All Saints'

In his update to the province on Monday 8th June 2020, Premier Doug Ford authorized places of worship to open from this Friday 12th June. While it is good to know that we may now legally open our church buildings for worship, our first priority must remain the welfare of our community.

The Anglican Diocese of Toronto, in partnership with the wider church, is working on a set of guidelines and protocols for all parishes, so that our worship can be shared in a way that is both responsible and safe.

Until those guidelines are published, and until our parish has been able to properly implement them, All Saints' will not be opening for public worship.

We are all eager to be with one another again, and perhaps we now will be sooner rather than later. As we continue to prepare for that day, we will continue to share new information as it is made available to us.
