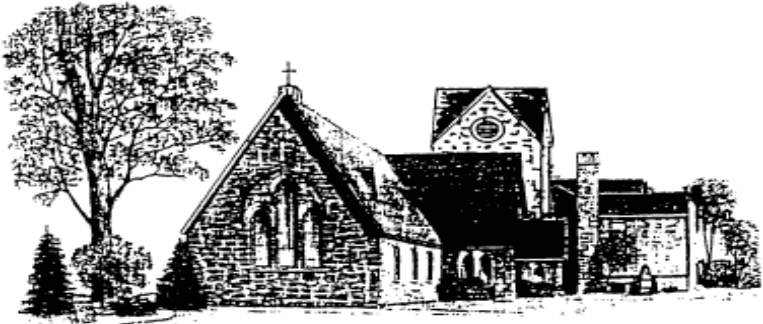

Land Acknowledgement
